

MORETON'S INTERNET AGREEMENT WITH STUDENTS

- 1 Students agree to use the Internet for constructive educational purposes.
- 2 Students will not visit sites which are offensive, illegal, defamatory or pornographic. Proxy sites will not be used.
- 3 Students will observe rules and laws of copyright and plagiarism.
- 4 Students will be fair with the network, refraining from time consuming downloads of large files.
- 5 Students will not give out personal details about home, school, addresses or telephone numbers.
- 6 Students must report to a member of staff any information they come across that makes them feel uncomfortable.



FACEBOOK and other social networking sites

Facebook is not accessible via the school computer network but it has come to our attention that some mobile devices, such as the new Smartphones or Blackberry-type phones can access Facebook via Wi-Fi technology.

At Moreton, mobile phones are **NOT ALLOWED** in school. Students who bring a mobile phone to school can leave it in the school reception, where it will be kept secure until the end of the school day.

Any student who is seen using a mobile phone in lessons will have it taken from them and it will **ONLY** be returned to parents.

The reason we are taking this action is to reduce the disruption caused in class if a phone is used and also to ensure no student is the subject of “cyber-bullying” via these social network sites.

No staff are allowed to contribute to any Facebook page of a student.

The school requests that parents monitor their child’s use of Facebook carefully to ensure they are not using it inappropriately.
